



Serving HCA: Volunteer Compliance

Please check with your campus secretary to determine if you are in compliance.

- 1. Go to preventandprotectstl.org
- 2. At LOGIN, click on the blue word REGISTER
- 3. Enter passcode: stlprotect
- 4. Select location: Holy Cross Academy
- 5. Complete your personal information using your legal name
- 6. Create username and password
- 7. Agree to the Terms of Use and click SUBMIT
- 8. You will then be prompted to submit info. for a background screening
- 9. If you haven't attended a "Protecting God's Children" workshop, you will be prompted to register. If you have previously attended a PGC workshop, the system will find you and ask you to confirm your previous record of attendance.
- 10. You will view two online training videos, and agree/sign the code of Ethical Conduct. The entire process should take 20-30 min. Unless you haven't done the PGC Workshop. Please contact your campus secretary if you have any questions.






News You Can Use
