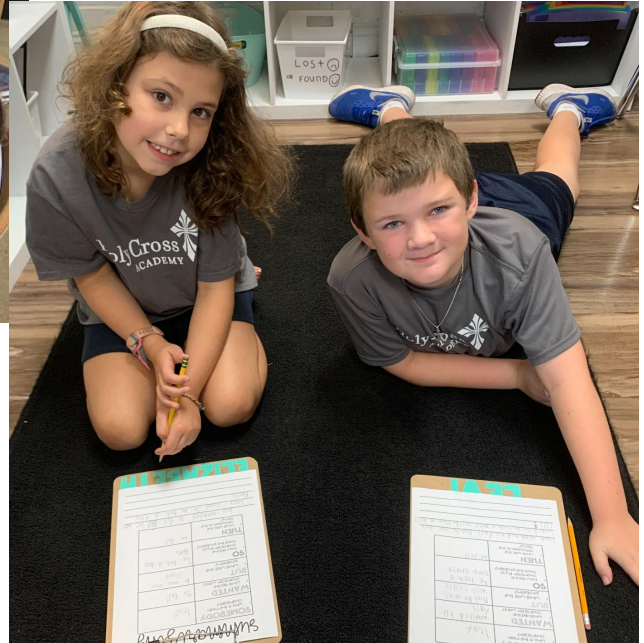

Legacy Gala

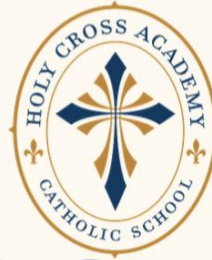
