#### ECEC LENT ACTIVITIES


The ECEC will be participating in many school wide Lenten activities. We have created a simplified Stations of the Cross with a few words about each station.

All Children will be screened on Wednesday, through a quick picture of their eyes. If there are any concerns the family will be contacted

Vision Screening Detects:

- Nearsightedness cannot see far away
- Farsightedness cannot see close up
- Astigmatism cannot see far away or close up Amblyopia "lazy eye"
- Anisometropia one eye sees clearly and one is blurred
- Anisocoria pupils are unequal
- Misalignment eye turning in or out
