Mask Change:

Registration for 2022-2023

March 1 will soon be here. After March 1 the registration fee for each ECEC student will change to \$200. Complete your child's re-enrollment this weekend to save the \$100. You will need to upload your child's immunization and a physical from within the last year. If your child has their yearly physical between March and July, you can simply take a photo of the current forms and upload them. The registration can't be completed without an image being uploaded.

March 2: Ash Wednesday

We will be starting Lent on March 2. Father Holtmann will be coming over to the school campus to give Ashes to the children and staff. We will have a small gathering in church. Each classroom will start counting the 40 days of Lent.

We encourage your family to start a Lenten calendar at home. For young children, we will encourage them to do 40 Acts of Kindness and service instead of "giving" up something for Lent. Acts of Kindness can include: making a picture or card for a neighbor, helping unload the dishwasher, visiting a neighbor or church member, praying for someone that is sick or far away, planting flowers together, painting pots to give flowers to others and other acts of kindness.
