# 2023 HCA K-8 Field Day Parent Information Friday, May 5, 2023 Intermediate Campus (OLP)

### **BEFORE THE STUDENTS ARRIVE:**

Please make sure your child eats a substantial breakfast. They should bring a snack and water bottle with their name on it. They can bring a cinch sack to carry their water bottle, snack and any other things they may want (hat, sunglasses, ect).

# FIELD DAY ATTIRE:

Students will have a dress down day but be given a specific color to wear. There will NOT be a Field Day T-shirt given to the students like in previous years. Students must follow dress down day guidelines. We want the students to have fun and be creative. See below for some examples of guidelines.

YES: hair dye/chalk, face paint, colored socks, hats, sunglasses, cinch sack, tutus

**NO:** inappropriate lengths on tops and bottoms, inappropriate sayings on shirts, bringing face paint or hair chalk day of to share with friends, wearing cut clothes, tank tops.

Parents should enter the lot via the church entrance, be directed around the school and will drop off at the door facing Sunray. If you arrive after 7:50, students will need to be dropped off at the office.

Pick Up Time: 11:30a.m.



There is NO afterschool program.


## **WEATHER ISSUES:**

If the weather is forecasted to be thundering/lightning on Field Day, there will still be a modified field day at each of the campuses. All students should report to their everyday campus. # **Spring Clean Your Allergies Away**

Spring is officially here and that means the return of spring allergy irritants! Follow the tips below to make sure your home is allergen-free this season.



Stay inside when pollen counts are high - use a pollen tracker to monitor levels in your area.



Make sure to keep windows and doors closed to help prevent allergens from entering your home and clean air filters often.



Clean and vacuum areas of your home that are prone to gather dirt and dust and wear a mask to prevent particle inhalation.



Pollen can stick to your hair and clothing so shower and change your clothes when you come in from outdoors.



Wear a protective mask when engaging in outdoor activities.
